Sun Care / Hat Policy

Taking into account recommendations from the Anti Cancer Foundation a EFS R-12 School Hat Policy has been adopted: Whenever outdoors, for lessons or breaks, students are encouraged to wear a broadbrimmed /bucket hat (Navy), use a broad spectrum sunscreen and wear Australian standard sunglasses. **For R-6 students, the wearing of a hat outside is compulsory in Term 1 and Term 4. 7-12 Campus students are encouraged to wear hats.** Hat/beanies are to be removed inside buildings.

Rationale

Eastern Fleurieu R-12 School has adopted a Uniform Policy in accordance with Department for Education School Dress Code Guidelines and in a consultative process involving the Governing Council, staff, students and parents.

We believe that a uniform will:

- promote pride, sense of belonging and a positive school image
- help to provide a safe school environment
- create an identification with the school and assist in identifying strangers on the school grounds
- maintain a high standard of appearance and creates equal status amongst students.

All students, Reception to Year 12 are required to dress in the school uniform.

EFS staff, parents and students support the school in ensuring that the approved uniform is worn. It is expected that students will maintain it and their appearance in a neat, clean and tidy manner at all times.

Non-Compliance

Students who choose not to comply with directives of the Uniform Policy will be managed via the Behaviour Management Policy. Consequences apply. Personal circumstances will be considered.

Requirements

Approved School Uniform - available for purchase through the school Uniform Shop.

Shirts

All tops display the school logo

- Navy blue/white polo shirt with logo
- Poly contrast Navy blue/white polo shirt with logo

Undershirts

- Navy blue/white only
- For warmth and comfort, longsleeves and skivvies are accepted.
- Hoodies are not permitted under any circumstances

Jumpers

- Quarter zip, navy blue with logo
- Rugby style, navy blue with logo
- Woollen jumper, navy blue with logo
- Hoodies are not permitted under any circumstances

Jackets

- Navy blue spray jacket with logo
- Navy blue soft shell jacket with logo

Shorts / Pants / Skirts / Skorts

- Shorts Plain navy blue or grey
- No brand names
- Trackpants - navy blue
- Pants - grey pants
- Skirts - Long and short styles, winter fabric
- Skorts (R-6 only) navy blue or grey
- Dress - Blue check, light summer fabric

Strictly not permitted - leggings / active tights / jeggings / hoodies and revealing shorts



Sports Uniform

- Navy/yellow PE shirt with logo
- Appropriate footwear

The sport uniform is compulsory for Year 7-9 (Middle School) students and for Senior Years students who study PE at 7-12 Campus. Students are required to change into appropriate clothing prior to the lesson and change at the end of the lesson, unless the PE lesson is at the end of the day.

When students across EFS R-12 School are involved in **external school sporting events**, uniforms will be provided.

Year 6 and Year 12 Commemorative Jumpers are produced each year and available for purchase.

Hats

- Bucket style / navy/white trim

Beanies and Scarves

- may be worn in plain school colours

Footwear

Comfortable, flat soled footwear

- sandshoes/leather school shoes
- sandals must have a heel strap
- slip-on shoes are not acceptable as per Work Health and Safety Guidelines
